Dear Sir or Madam:

This is a request under the Freedom of Information Act/Privacy Act (FOIA/PA) 5 U.S.C. 552). We are currently contracted by Lockheed Martin to review available records regarding past hazardous substance usage and waste generation, including radioactive materials, at the above-referenced study area.

This study area, including former Building D, was referenced in an NRC Region I Inspection Report (No. 94-001) dated January 25, 1995. The NRC inspection occurred on November 3, 1994 and was performed by Stephen Holmes of NRC. License Nos. 19-01398-32, SNM-11, SNM-53, SNM-1192, and STB-187 are all registered to the former Building D at Strawberry Point. Also, we understand that there have been NRC reports on the licensed activities at Building D (NRC Report Nos. 040-03296/82-01 and 040-02308/82-011).

We are interested in obtaining data from NRC files and/or copies of documents related to all the above-referenced licenses, inspections, and NRC reports. Of particular interest would be records that itemize and/or list quantities of chemicals and radioactive materials that were obtained, stored or used, and quantities of hazardous or radioactive wastes generated, shipped and/or disposed in connection with the above licenses and related facility activities.
