SUMMARY

By application dated September 20, 2007, QSA Global, Inc. (QSA), submitted a renewal request for the Model No. 770 package. QSA did not request any changes to the package design or its contents. The certificate has been renewed for a term expiring on March 31, 2013.

EVALUATION

QSA requested renewal of Certificate of Compliance No. 9148 for the Model No. 770 package by application dated September 20, 2007. The applicant did not request any design changes to the package. The staff reviewed the documents referenced in the certificate and determined that the required documentation was available and complete.
