This refers to the inspection conducted by A. T. Boland of this office on June 7-11, 1993. The inspection included a review of activities authorized for your Watts Bar facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the report.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observation of activities in progress.

Within the scope of the inspection, no violations or deviations were identified. However, your attention is directed to the ALARA issue discussed in Paragraph 8 of the enclosed report. We note the apparent lack of progress in resolving the deficiencies identified during the ALARA design walkdown. We are concerned that inadequate or untimely dispositioning of the deficiencies could result in unnecessary future worker radiation exposure. We will be reviewing your progress in future inspections.
