SUBJECT: NOTICE OF VIOLATION

(NRC INSPECTION REPORT NOS. 50-390/92-05 AND 50-391/92-05)

This refers to the NRC inspection conducted by G. A. Walton on February 21 through March 19, 1992. The inspection included a review of activities authorized for your Watts Bar facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed report.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observation of activities in progress.

Based on the results of this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Notice of Violation (Notice). The violation addresses deficiencies in procedures for the control of scaffolding and rigging activities during performance of modification work activities. We are concerned about this issue because of potential damage to safety related equipment if loads from scaffolds and rigging aren't adequately controlled. At the completion of the inspection period an increase in management attention to resolve these deficiencies and prevent further violations was noted.

You are required to respond to this letter and should follow the instructions specified in the enclosed Notice when preparing your response. In your response, you should document the specific actions taken and any additional actions you plan to prevent recurrence. After reviewing your response to this Notice, including your proposed corrective actions and the results of future inspections, the NRC will determine whether further NRC enforcement action is necessary to ensure compliance with NRC regulatory requirements.

In addition, this inspection identified that, although recent engineering records were complete, originial construction records for several conduit supports could not be retrieved. This indicates a potential weakness in your QA records corrective action program that warrants your attention.
