Dear Sir or Madam:

TXU Generation Company LP (d/b/a Luminant Power), acting on behalf of Texas Energy Future Holdings Limited Partnership (Texas Energy LP) and itself, hereby submit the following additional information in connection with the indirect transfer of control of facility operating licenses as approved by NRC in Reference 1 above.

As stated in the letter of Reference 2 above, closing of the transaction and the resulting indirect transfer of control of operating licenses as approved in Reference 1 are targeted for Wednesday, October 10, 2007. On that date, Texas Energy LP will acquire all of the outstanding equity of TXU Corp. In the near future after closing of the acquisition of TXU Corp., Goldman plans to substitute William Young for Steven Feldman as one of its three designees to the TXU Corp. board of directors. Like Mr. Feldman, Mr. Young is a U.S. citizen and an employee of Goldman. A short biography of Mr. Young is attached.
