Route Approval Application (NRC No. 209)

Route: Browns Ferry Nuclear Plant to GE Vallecitos Nuclear Center

By application dated September 14, 2007, TLI-Secured Transportation Services requested approval of a route to transport spent fuel from Browns Ferry Nuclear Plant near Athens, Alabama to the GE Vallecitos Nuclear Center in Sunol, California. This request identifies and requests additional information needed by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff in order to complete its review of the application and to determine whether the applicant has demonstrated compliance with the regulatory requirements.

1. Provide assurance that arrangements will be made, prior to each shipping campaign along this route, for escorts in accordance with *Title 10 of the Federal Code of Regulations (10 CFR)73.37(c)(2)* and with the applicable additional security measures for transport of SNF issued on October 3, 2002 for NRC licensees who ship greater than 100 g of SNF.
2. Verify and re-submit the 24-hour emergency contact information provided along the proposed route from Browns Ferry Nuclear Plant to GE Vallecitos Nuclear Center.

The emergency contact number for Jeff Davis County is not a 24-hour number and should be updated. The 24-hour emergency contact information ensures that local law enforcement assistance is available while the spent fuel shipment is in transit in accordance with the requirements of *10 CFR 73.37*.
