Operational Status

Indian Point Unit 2 is operating at 100 percent power and has been online for 49 days. Unit 3 is operating at 100 percent reactor power and has been on line for 77 days.

Siren Project

Entergy is continuing the test of the new siren system in the four-county Emergency Planning Zone. There will be a series of "silent" tests in which the siren will receive a signal but will not sound. Residents near the siren may hear a small pop followed by a noise similar to a microphone keying or a radio tuning.

In addition the silent tests, there will be two full volume soundings-Sat., Aug. 11 at 10 a.m. and another on Tues., Aug. 14 at 6:30 p.m.

Entergy has committed to the NRC to have the system operational by Aug. 24.
