Dear Mr. Price:

This refers to your letter of December 23, 1966 with respect to an inspection of our activities under AEC Byproduct Materials Licenses 37-2006-5, -6.

A more stringent control program has been instituted to insure future compliance with regulations. The following steps have been taken:

1. The 35mc cobalt 60 source has been, and will continue to be, leak tested in accordance with condition 14c of our license 37-2006-5;
2. The 3mc americium source has been disposed of in accordance with provisions of 10CFR20. We shall not obtain any more americium 241 in excess of the license limits (37-2006-5);
3. All future contemplated uses of radioactive material will be reviewed in accordance with accepted policies before authorization to work is given or before work is undertaken;
4. All future uses of radioactive material suspected of releasing airborne concentrations in excess of limits established in the 10CFR20 regulations will be monitored.

Additional personnel have been hired to strengthen control of these materials and a program to insure continuing compliance with the regulations will be developed by our Health Physicist.
