
Dear Ms. Kauffman:

In our telephone conversation of October 9, 2007, we discussed ABB's recent license amendment request to incorporate FUSRAP areas into NRC License No. 06-00217-06 (Reference). That request refers the reader to the CE Windsor Site Decommissioning Plan (DP), approved by the NRC in June 2004, for identification of the FUSRAP areas. You pointed out correctly that the list of FUSRAP areas in the DP did not include all areas listed in our recent (September 14, 2007) presentation to the NRC at Region I, specifically, the Equipment Storage Yard, which will be addressed by our amended DP submittal in November.

In response to this observation, I think it appropriate to explain that the approved DP is for the entire CE Windsor Site, but that the FUSRAP areas identified in the DP were those that would be addressed for remediation by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (ACE). As such, NRC would exert no authority over these areas with respect to ABB's NRC license requirements and regulations. By submitting the September 14 amendment request, it was ABB's intent to simply return the FUSRAP areas listed in the DP to explicit NRC authority, thereby returning the entire Site to NRC authority.
