WATTS BAR NUCLEAR PLANT (WBN) - NRC INSPECTION REPORT NO. 390, 391/94-11, REVISION TO PREVIOUS RESPONSE TO NOTICE OF VIOLATION (EXAMPLE 1)

By letter dated April 15, 1994, TVA responded to a notice of violation with two examples cited. Example one identified procedures that were issued with references to procedures which were no longer valid. TVA stated the reason for example one of the violation was as follows:

"The violation resulted from insufficient clarity and misunderstanding of the controlling procedures for review of references and inattention to detail by procedure preparers and reviewers. The effect of the violation would generally be limited to procedure performance delays due to the need to research additional documents, make procedure changes, etc."

After further review, it was determined that the initial cause determination was incorrect. TVA determined that the procedural requirements were correct. The cause for example one of the violation was limited to lack of attention to detail by procedure preparers, sponsors, and technical reviewers.

With the exception of the need to revise the controlling procedure, which is no longer needed, the corrective actions taken and results achieved, and corrective steps taken to avoid further violation remain valid. TVA is currently in full compliance with regards to the violation.
