WATTS BAR NUCLEAR PLANT (WBN) UNITS 1 AND 2 - NOTICE OF VIOLATION (NOV) 50-390, 391/94-13-01, EXAMPLE 4 - FULL COMPLIANCE DATE CHANGE

The purpose of this letter is to notify NRC that the date when full compliance will be achieved for the subject NOV has been rescheduled.

In a letter to NRC dated July 25, 1994, TVA provided a revised response to the subject NOV and stated that full compliance would be achieved upon disposition and closure of Problem Evaluation Report (PER) WBPER940374. The deficiencies documented in WBPER940374 have been extensively evaluated for extent of condition and apparent cause. Recurrence controls and corrective actions have been developed and approved for implementation. Some recurrence controls and corrective actions have been completed. However, additional time is required to complete the remaining actions and close the PER. Therefore, TVA has rescheduled the date for WBPER940374 closure to March 17, 1995.
