With respect to the additional Seventy Dollar (\$70.00) fee required for our request for an amendment to Source Material License SMB-1005 dated June 5, 1980, I am requesting an extension to the deadline for payment of this fee.

I was informed by the NRC Licensing Branch sometime after the above application for amendment was made, that this request could not be processed until a previous amendment naming myself as the new Radiation Safety Officer was approved. Also, at the time of the above communication it was pointed out that there was a problem with our application for the amendment to SMB 1005 that would probably prevent its approval.


The problem with this amendment involves a small amount of Pu-238 we are attempting to transfer from SNM license 1199 to SMB 1005. Within the next few weeks I hope to turn this material over to the Department of Energy Pu-238 Reclaiming Facility at Savannah River.

After the Pu-238 is transferred, I will be submitting a revised draft of the application for amendment to SMB 1005.

If it meets with your approval, I would like to submit the additional Seventy Dollars (\$70.00) application fee with the revised application.
