By letter dated October 2, 2007 (ML072851218), Energy Metals Corporation (Energy Metals) submitted a source material license application for the Moore Ranch Uranium Project (Moore Ranch), in Campbell County, Wyoming. The current Moore Ranch construction and operating schedule includes construction of a Central Processing Plant and the development, production, and restoration of three wellfields over an approximate 11 year period (2009 through 2020).

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff acknowledges receipt of your application. Currently, NRC staff is conducting an acceptance review of the application. If found acceptable, NRC staff will docket the application. Generally, the determination on acceptability for docketing will be made within a period of ninety days from the date of receipt of the application.
