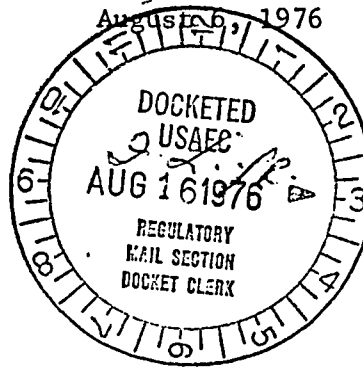

All information contained in application dated June 10, 1975 is still applicable except in two instances:

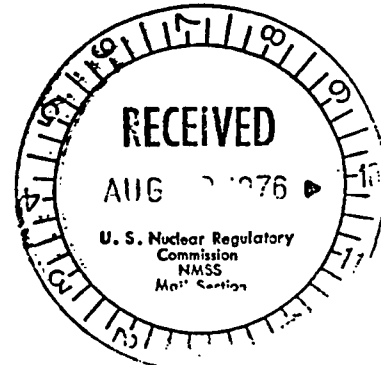
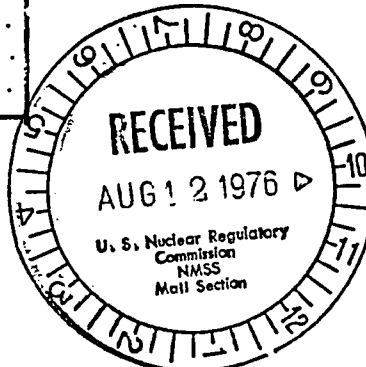
- (1) The unaltered source material will be returned to the ERDA contractor, the United States Air Force or other licensed organization at the conclusion of these tests.
