It is desired that the following be added to item 9 (authorized places of use):

"G. Cape Canaveral Air Force Station, Florida, 32925.

H. Temporary job sites anywhere in the United States where the Nuclear Regulatory Commission maintains jurisdiction for regulating the use of source material."


All information in the following previous correspondence is still applicable:

At Cape Canaveral, it is intended that depleted uranium metal alloy will be used in mass simulator tests.

The unaltered source material will be returned to the ERDA contractor, the United States Air Force, and United States Navy, or other licensed organization at the conclusion of these tests.
