Dear Mr. Ward:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 31 amending your NRC Material License No. 24-13365-01 in accordance with your letter dated June 5, 2007, requesting the NRC approve the release of the Buildings C and G located in Columbia, Missouri for unrestricted use. Based on our review of the documentation you submitted in support of the request, we have determined that you have satisfactorily demonstrated that Buildings C and G located at 7200 E. ABC Lane, Columbia, Missouri, do not contain residual radiological contamination in excess of NRC release limits. As a result, the buildings can be released for unrestricted use.

The NRC staff prepared an Environmental Assessment (EA) and Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) regarding your proposed amendment to release Buildings C and G for unrestricted use. An announcement was made in the Federal Register dated October 11, 2007, related to the EA and FONSI.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS).
