**SUBJECT: CONFIRMATORY SURVEY NEEDED TO TERMINATE LICENSE**

Dear Dr. Reynolds:

This letter is being sent to you because the Commission requires that licensees submit information, in writing, from which the Commission can conclude that no residual radioactive contamination exists at the licensee's facilities before a license is terminated. On March 13, 2007, Steven Courtemanche of my staff contacted Loren Bertocci, Ph.D., your Radiation Safety Officer, to determine if Salem International University intended to renew the license. Dr. Bertocci stated that the University would not be renewing the license and would submit a request to terminate the license to the NRC Region I office. Mr. Courtemanche, at that time, reminded Dr. Bertocci that the licensee would be required to submit a history of usage of licensed material at the University and a confirmatory survey of those areas where licensed materials were used. As of this date, no request or confirmatory survey has been received. Already on file, is information regarding the disposal of licensed material which the University had acquired in the past; however, if any contaminated materials are identified during the confirmatory survey, an accounting must be made of the disposal of those materials as well. On October 24, 2007, Mr. Courtemanche left a voice-mail message for Dr. Bertocci regarding the need to submit the above information to the Commission.

10 CFR 30.36(d) requires, in part, that the licensee provide notification, in writing, within 60 days of the expiration of the license, and begin decommissioning of the facility. Your license expired on March 31, 2007. Please indicate, in writing, your progress towards identifying residual contamination at your facility and your timeline towards submitting the information that the Commission needs to terminate your license.
