This is in reference to your application dated May 23, 1983, to review License Number SUB-831. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. You indicate 5 places of use in item 5 your application. Please indicate which of the activities outlined in item 7 of your application are located at each place of use.
2. You indicate in item 5 of your application use at temporary job sites, what type of use will occur at these job sites and please submit a complete description of management controls established to ensure that materials are used in a safe manner and in compliance with applicable Federal Regulations and the terms and conditions of your license. In addition, we need a description of the minimum training and experience of persons responsible for use at temporary job sites, the minimum acceptable facilities and equipment that will be required for temporary job sites and a description of your radiation safety and emergency procedures to be used at temporary job sites.
3. You should modify your shipper's certification in your safety manual to reflect recent changes in NRC (10 CFR 71) and DOT (49 CFR 170-189) regulations.

We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. Please reply in duplicate to my attention at the Region I office and refer to Mail Control No. 01403.
