This is to update Neutron's response of January 5, 2007 to Violation "I" of the referenced Notice of Violation.

Subsequent to your August 2006 inspection, the writing, the approval, and training on Procedure R-5506 Revision 0, "Corrective and Preventive Action Radioactive Material Transportation," was completed. After working with the Corrective Actions of 2006, Neutron has instead decided to expand, modify and implement Neutron's corporate Procedure C9003, Corrective and Preventative Action to include the shipment of radioactive materials.

We believe that doing so will bring the broader experience of other QA personnel to the shipment of radioactive material, and will minimize the potential for future confusion.
