MEMORANDUM AND ORDER
(Scheduling Further Filings)

On October 22, 2007, this Licensing Board conducted in Madison, Indiana a combined evidentiary hearing and oral argument in this matter involving the Licensee U. S. Army's Jefferson Proving Ground site at that location. At its conclusion, the Board announced that it would enter a formal order establishing a schedule for the filing and service of proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law with respect to the issues presented by the Intervenor, Save the Valley, Inc., in its admitted Contention B-1. This order provides that schedule and, in addition, addresses the matter of the submission of transcript corrections with regard to the October 22 proceedings.

1. Each party shall file and serve its proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law no later than 5:00 p.m. (EST) on Friday, November 30, 2007. Each such proposed finding shall include a specific reference to the portion or portions of the evidentiary record of the proceeding that is deemed to provide support for the finding. Absent such reference, a proposed finding will receive no consideration by the Board.

2. If it so chooses, each party may file, no later than 5:00 p.m. (EST) on Wednesday, December 12, 2007, a response in opposition to one or more of the proposed findings and
