Subject: FYI - CALL WITH EPA TODAY ON STATUS OF YUCCA MOUNTAIN STANDARD

Late today I connected with Elizabeth Cotsworth, EPA Director of the Office of Radiation and Indoor Air. The purpose of my call was to determine the current status of EPA's Yucca Mountain radiation standard for the period beyond 10,000 years. Recall that we had previously been informed by EPA about the Administrator's intent to issue the standard by the end of June. Elizabeth confirmed that the standard is being reviewed by OMB and that EPA staff were briefing the acting Assistant Administrator for Air and Radiation and the Deputy Administrator during the next several days. She thought that there could be a meeting with OMB about the standard as early as the end of next week.
