**RESOLUTION OF THE SCREVEN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
SUPPORTING AN EXPANSION TO PLANT VOGTLE**

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the Screven County Board of Commissioners supports the concept of nuclear energy as a means of supplying a clean and reliable source of energy for the citizens of Georgia and elsewhere; and

WHEREAS, Northern Screven County is within a few miles proximity of the Plant Vogtle site; and

WHEREAS, Plant Vogtle has been a good corporate neighbor and vital to the surrounding communities through the availability of jobs and other economic opportunities; and

WHEREAS, Southern Nuclear Operating Company has filed an application for an Early Site Permit for the Vogtle site with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission which, if granted, could lead to the construction of additional nuclear facilities on the site; and

WHEREAS, the Screven County Board of Commissioners supports this project and requests that the Nuclear Regulatory Commission consider the application of Southern Nuclear Operating Company favorably.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Screven County Board of Commissioners unanimously supports the application of Southern Nuclear Operating Company for an Early Site Permit and requests the Nuclear Regulatory Commission to approve the application for permit.
