Subject: Clarification on FUSRAP Associated Areas at Windsor, CT
(NOTE: This will be used as the Documents Title in ADAMS)

Summary: Mr. Conant was called in order to get clarification relative to what FUSRAP areas are actually involved in the request to include the FUSRAP areas onto the license. This clarification is needed since the FUSRAP areas listed in the decommissioning plan (DP) dated October 15, 2003 (**laydown area**, drum burial pit, clam shell pile, debris pile, site brook, building 6 and waste lines, and building 3) are different than those listed during the September 14, 2007, public meeting presentation (**woods area**, drum burial pit, clam shell pile, debris pile, site brook, building 3 and industrial waste line , building 6, and **equipment storage yard**). Conant explained that the laydown area (also called the waste pad area) has been renamed the woods area and the equipment storage yard was treated as a NRC licensed area in the DP but is now viewed as a FUSRAP associated area. He stated that this will be clarified as part of the DP revision soon to be submitted to the NRC.

The letter of clarification that Mr. Conant issued to Laurie Kauffman on 10/18/2007 was meant to clarify that the inclusion of the FUSRAP-associated areas onto the license puts all of the areas shown on Figure 4-11 of the DP back onto the NRC license. This area includes all impacted site areas (NRC licensed and FUSRAP areas) regardless of how they were previously classified or what they were previously named.
