Dear Nuclear Regulatory Commission Chief:

Please accept this letter as my endorsement of the Early Site Permit submitted for additional nuclear units at Plant Vogtle in Burke County, Georgia. Nuclear energy is important in meeting the electric power needs of our citizens in Georgia, as well as throughout the nation.

Nuclear energy supplies electricity to one in five American homes and businesses. Nuclear power plants provide low-cost, predictable power at stable prices. And these plants are essential in maintaining the reliability of the U.S. electric power system.
