ANNETTE VIETTI-COOK: We have a final rule to amend 10 CFR Parts 19, 20, and 50: Occupational Dose Records, Labeling Containers, and the Total Effective Dose Equivalent. The Commission is being asked to act on a final rule that amends certain requirements for the reporting of annual dose to workers, amends the definition of total effective dose equivalent, amends certain container labeling requirements, and removes the requirement that licensees attempt to obtain the records of cumulative occupational radiation dose for certain individuals. The Commission has voted to approve the publication and implementation of this final rule, subject to the changes in the attachment. Would the Commissioners in the room please affirm your vote?
