Based on our recent conversations and the investigation process associated with our renewal of License 1300772-02, we have concluded the Ni-63 sources that were utilized in analytical equipment are no longer on our premises. The investigation process included a comprehensive physical search and records review. We have also completed the notification pursuant to 10 CFR § 20.2201 (Reports of theft or loss of licensed material). In addition, we have no continuing need for the sources, and in the unlikely event they are located on-site, we will arrange to have the sources transferred to Agilent for proper handling. Therefore, we request that our NRC Material License be amended to delete the Ni-63 sources from our license.
