Pursuant to your request stemming from the October 17, 2007 inspection of facilities at Gettysburg College, I am writing to inform the NRC of two personnel changes in our license (SNM-245):

1. Dr. Bernadette Connors, who is listed as an authorized radiation user, left the program in August of 2005 in order to begin a faculty appointment at Millsaps College. Her current address is Biology Department, Millsaps College, 1701 N. State St., Jackson MS 39210.
2. Professor Theresa Amott (*sic* Arnott), Vice Provost at Gettysburg College, left her post in fall of 2006. Professor James White replaced Dr. Amott as Vice Provost, and he has assumed administrative oversight of the RSO and the college's radiation program.


