
Dear Mr. Matthews:

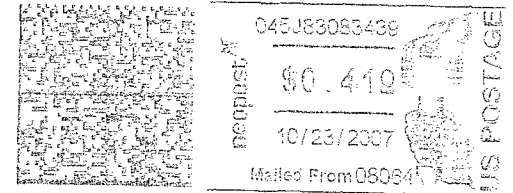
