

MATERIALS LICENSE

Pursuant to the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, the Energy Reorganization Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-438), and Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter I, Parts 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 39, 40, and 70, and in reliance on statements and representations heretofore made by the licensee, a license is hereby issued authorizing the licensee to receive, acquire, possess, and transfer byproduct, source, and special nuclear material designated below; to use such material for the purpose(s) and at the place(s) designated below; to deliver or transfer such material to persons authorized to receive it in accordance with the regulations of the applicable Part(s). This license shall be deemed to contain the conditions specified in Section 183 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, and is subject to all applicable rules, regulations, and orders of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission now or hereafter in effect and to any conditions specified below.

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9. Authorized Use:

A. Pursuant to Section 32.11, 10 CFR Part 32, "Specific Domestic Licenses to Manufacture or Transfer Certain Items Containing Byproduct Material"; the licensee is authorized to distribute processed topaz containing byproduct materials as listed in License Conditions 6 and 7, not to exceed concentrations as specified in 10 CFR 30.70, Schedule A, to persons exempt from licensing pursuant to Section 30.14, 10 CFR Part 30, or equivalent provisions of the regulations of any Agreement State.

CONDITIONS

- 10. This license does not authorize possession or use of licensed material.
- 11. Licensed material shall be distributed only from the licensee's facility located at 98 Alexandria Pike, Suite 42, Warrenton, VA.
- 12. The licensee shall submit periodic material transfer reports as specified in Section 32.12, 10 CFR Part 32.
- 13. The licensee shall not accept any material unless it is accompanied by a certificate indicating that the material has been analyzed and found to contain less than exempt concentrations as specified in Sections 30.14 and 30.70, 10 CFR Part 30. The licensee shall verify that the measurement process was adequate to measure radioactivity below exempt concentrations.
