Dear Dr. Klein,

Since the resumption of the nuclear safety dialogue between USNRC and AERB in February 2003, substantial progress has been made in the work done under this co-operation. This comprises of 8 discussion meetings/workshops on topics of mutual interest with the last of these meetings being held during January 8 – 12, 2007 in Washington D.C. These discussions have been marked by high level of technical expertise from both sides and we found them extremely useful. The USNRC has also hosted two of our young colleagues for a one year period starting July 2006 and they have derived immense professional benefit from this deputation. Further, with your encouragement, the joint exercises of benchmarking Computer Codes for Analysis using Standard Problems have also been initiated. During the last discussion meeting held in Washington D.C., the proposal for conducting an Indo-US seminar on Nuclear Safety during end 2007/beginning 2008 time frame in Mumbai was accepted which would add further value to our co-operation. Incidentally, 15 November 2007 would mark the beginning of the silver jubilee year of AERB and holding such a seminar during this period would add significant value to the celebrations.

You might recall that I extended an invitation to you to visit India when we met on the sidelines of the IAEA General Conference in Vienna in September 2006. This invitation was renewed through my colleague Mr. S.K. Chande who led the AERB delegation for the last USNRC-AERB discussion meeting in Washington D.C. in January 2007.
