SUMMARY

This refers to your letter dated October 16, 2007, requesting an amendment to your NRC byproduct materials license and to the telephone discussion on November 2, 2007, between you and me. We find that we need additional information as follows:

1. As discussed with my supervisor, Ms. Pelke, it would be best to not pursue naming Mr. Schweagerl as an Assistant RSO at this time in favor of having him complete his training and experience on the S-10, etc. and re-applying at a later date to become an Alternate RSO.

As Alternate RSO, Mr. Schweagerl would have to be equivalently and fully qualified as RSO, which includes a reasonable level of experience in regulatory affairs with us. This experience can be obtained in a variety of ways, including serving as the primary contact during an NRC inspection; involvement in an NRC-attended loading of the irradiators; involvement in preparation of licensing correspondence; and study and understanding of the documents forming the basis of your NRC license, NRC regulatory requirements in 10 CFR 19, 20, 30, 36 and 21 and guidance in NUREG 1556 Vol 6. Involvement in your internal corporate audits and in training new irradiator operators will also prove useful.

Mr. Schweagerl should also be completely qualified and trained on both the S-10 and S-8 irradiators, especially operating and emergency procedures.

If you decide to pursue this course of action, you may name more than one alternate RSO to your license. In that event, please designate who the primary RSO will be and who will sequentially succeed that individual as RSO and act as RSO only in the physical absence of the RSO. Please also briefly justify and support your request to name multiple RSOs, if you elect to do so.

We will also need a signed and dated statement from Mr. Schweagerl attesting that he accepts the position as Alternate RSO for this license and he understands the duties and responsibilities associated with this position.

As you agreed to our voiding this action at this time, we are doing so without prejudice to the resubmission of your request in the future.

Please also be reminded of the provisions in 10 CFR 30.9(a), "Completeness and accuracy of information,"..."(a) Information provided to the Commission by an applicant for a license or by a licensee or information required by statute or by the Commission's regulations, orders, or license conditions to be maintained by the applicant or the licensee shall be complete and accurate in all material respects" and the provisions in 10 CFR 30.10 concerning "Deliberate misconduct."
