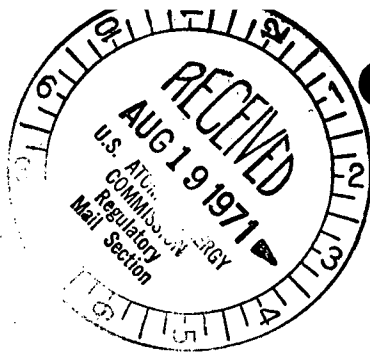

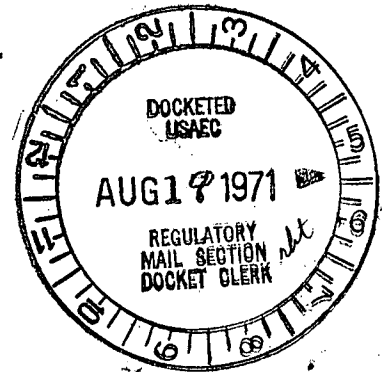

Dear Dr. Morris:

Thank you for your letter informing us that the Tennessee Valley Authority, Knoxville, Tennessee, has filed an application for construction permits and facility licenses to authorize construction and operation of two pressurized water nuclear reactors, designated as the Watts Bar Nuclear Plant Units 1 and 2, on the west bank of the Tennessee River, Rhea County, Tennessee (Dockets Nos. 50-390 and 50-391).

Because you have examined the National Register of Historic Places and found that there are no listings in Rhea County or any Register properties within the general vicinity of the proposed plant, the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation will not comment on the proposal.
