SUBJECT: WATTS BAR UNIT 1 - SUPPLEMENTAL SAFETY EVALUATION ON THE  
INSTRUMENT LINES CORRECTIVE ACTION PROGRAM (TAC NO. M71918)

By letter dated March 11, 1994, TVA provided Revision 3 of the Instrument Lines Corrective Action Program (CAP). TVA stated that the revision was to clarify the pressure testing being performed for Seismic Category I or I(L) safety-related instrumentation, as discussed in a TVA letter dated January 31, 1994.

The staff has reviewed Revision 3 of the Instrument Lines CAP, and agrees that this revision clarifies the requirements for testing as TVA stated, and is similar to the testing procedure at Sequoyah. Implementation of the program, as revised, is subject to the staff's inspections. On such basis, the staff finds that Revision 3 is acceptable. This review was performed by Mr. Hukam Garg, in consultation with Mr. Michael Glasman of Region II.
