The purpose of this letter is to provide Revision 2 to the
proposed technical specification changes that were requested by a
letter dated January 10, 1997, and revised by letter dated
May 2, 1997.

During a conversation with the NRC Project Manager, R. Martin, on
May 14, 1997, TVA agreed to make two changes to the technical
specification amendment request. The following changes are being
made:

- 1) Technical Specification, page 5.0-28, last paragraph on the
markup page only, delete the word "Primary" to be consistent
with the remainder of the amendment request. This change was
correct on the typed page that incorporated the proposed
revision.
- 2) Technical Specification Bases page B 3.6-26, third sentence,
delete the word "required" to be consistent with NEI 94-01.
This change affects both the markup page and the typed page
that incorporated the proposed revision.
