NOTICE OF SPECIAL PREHEARING CONFERENCE  
(April 1, 1977)

A notice of opportunity to file petitions for leave to intervene in this proceeding involving consideration of issuance of facility operating licenses to the Applicant, was published by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) in the Federal Register on December 27, 1976 (41 F.R. 56244). Such notice provided that any person whose interest may be affected by this proceeding may file a petition for leave to intervene by January 26, 1977 in accordance with the provisions of 10 C.F.R. §2.714.

In response to this notice, a timely petition dated January 26, 1977 was filed by Jeannine W. Honicker of Nashville, Tennessee, appearing pro se. Oppositions to such petition were filed by the Applicant on February 10, 1977 and by the NRC Staff on February 8, 1977, respectively.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that a special prehearing conference pursuant to the provisions of Section 2.751a of the Commission's

Rules of Practice (10 C.F.R. §2.751a), will be held at  
10:00 a.m., local time, on May 12, 1977 at the <sup>Rhea County</sup> Circuit Court  
Chamber, Old Brady Building, Second Avenue, Dayton, Tennessee.  
All parties and any petitioners for intervention or their  
counsel are directed to appear at such special prehearing  
conference to consider all intervention petitions, including  
the interest of petitioners under either the judicial stand-  
ing tests for intervention as a matter of right, or interven-  
tion as a matter of discretion, as well as the identification  
of at least one relevant contention with reasonable  
specificity and with some basis assigned for it.
