WATTS BAR NUCLEAR PLANT (WBN) UNITS 1 AND 2 - COMPLIANCE WITH 10 CFR 50.63,  
STATION BLACKOUT (SBO) - REVISED IMPLEMENTATION SCHEDULE (TAC NUMBERS M68624  
AND M68625)

The purpose of this letter is to provide the NRC with a revised schedule for  
completion of commitments associated with TVA's position for compliance with  
10 CFR 50.63, the SBO Rule, for WBN.

In TVA's letters dated August 31, 1992, January 27, 1993 and April 28, 1993,  
TVA stated that the implementation of the equipment-related modification and  
procedure changes was to be two years following the NRC's issuance of the SBO  
final Safety Evaluation for WBN in accordance with 10 CFR 50.63(c)(4). The  
NRC's final Safety Evaluation for this issue was dated September 9, 1993.  
Consequently, the schedule for completion of implementation of SBO  
commitments was September 9, 1995. TVA has reevaluated the workscope and  
schedule for compliance with 10 CFR 50.63 for WBN. Implementation of the SBO  
Rule, including the modification and procedure related actions, will be  
completed before fuel load of the respective units. TVA currently plans to  
load fuel in WBN Unit 1 in the Fall of 1994.
