WATTS BAR NUCLEAR PLANT (WBN) - CABLE ISSUES CORRECTIVE ACTION PROGRAM PLAN,  
REVISION 3

The purpose of this letter is to provide the NRC with Revision 3 of the Cable Issues Corrective Action Program (CAP) Plan. TVA determined that a revision was warranted to incorporate previously submitted information concerning cable issues. Because of the complexity of this issue, a number of separate submittals were used to resolve CAP issues. Until now, the information in these letters had not been incorporated in the text of the CAP itself. This revision provides a summary of the previously submitted information and a reference to the associated submittals. The submittals which constitute the basis for this revision are shown in the CAP revision log. Please note Attachment 2, "Flowchart of CAP Activities," and Attachment 3, "Fragnet" have been deleted, since they are no longer needed.

NRC previously reviewed and accepted TVA's Cable Issues programs as documented in Safety Evaluation Reports dated April 25, 1991, and April 24, 1992, and Appendix Y to Supplement Safety Evaluation Report 9, dated June 16, 1992. NRC's acceptance of this program was based upon the review of the previous CAP revisions and the subsequent submitted information discussed above.

No new commitments are made by this submittal. However, previous commitments are updated in this revision to reflect progress made to date. In addition, an allowance for cables which fall within the critical cable-jam ratio range to be pulled with engineering approval has been added to section 4.1.2. This addition provides consistency with current TVA cable installation requirements.
