By letter dated January 13, 1994, Mr. W. Museler submitted Revision 3 of the Cable Issues Corrective Action Program. He stated that the purpose of the revision was to incorporate all the changes that had been previously approved by the staff, but had not been incorporated in the text of the CAP itself. We understand that the information submitted by numerous TVA letters was approved in Appendix P of Supplement 7 and Appendix T of Supplement 9 of the Watts Bar Safety Evaluation Report (NUREG-0847).

We reviewed Revision 3 by selectively comparing changes to those previously approved. We confirmed that Revision 3 does reflect the approved changes, and agree that, based on our sample of the changes, Revision 3 only reflects those approved changes. However, we did not review Revision 3 in detail to independently confirm that it does not contain technical information not previously approved by the staff.

This completes our effort. The review was performed by Mr. Hukam Garg.
