PROGRAM (RIP) CORRECTIVE ACTION PROGRAM PLAN

Enclosed is the revised RIP Corrective Action Program (CAP) Plan for WBN
Unit 1. Based upon discussion with NRC, this CAP has been revised to
clarify TVA's position with regard to Generic Letter 91-05.

WBN's program for procurement and dedication of materials is based upon
and complies with the guidance set forth in Generic Letters 91-05 and
89-02. The program is implemented through site procedures. As
noted in NRC Inspection Report 50-390/94-201, the applicable procedures
have been reviewed by NRC with positive results with regards to the
generic letters. Thus, TVA has removed the previous statement of
exception from the latest RIP CAP revision (Revision 6 enclosed).

It is TVA's understanding that with this change, NRC will be able to
complete its review of the RIP CAP.
