WATTS BAR NUCLEAR PLANT (WBN) - UNIT 1 - NRC INSPECTION OF WATTS BAR'S ENVIRONMENTAL QUALIFICATION (EQ) AND MECHANICAL EQUIPMENT QUALIFICATION (MEQ) SPECIAL PROGRAMS

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The purpose of this letter is to notify NRC of TVA's intent to reschedule its readiness for an NRC inspection of the EQ/MEQ Special Programs implementation. The inspection is currently scheduled for October 31 through November 10, 1994.

As discussed in recent Corrective Action Program meetings, it is critical that our comprehensive pre-inspection review be conducted prior to the inspection. Based on the implementation status of the project and complexity of the subject, TVA requests NRC to perform its onsite inspection after December 5, 1994.

The schedule for this NRC inspection was discussed with NRC Region II staff in a telephone conversation on October 24, 1994.
