By letter dated October 23, 1995, TVA responded to my letter of October 13, 1995 regarding 95-ERA-20. The staff has reviewed TVA's response and determined that TVA's actions in response to the administrative law judge's (ALJ) decision are sufficient to allow the staff to proceed with its licensing considerations.

In addition, the staff has reviewed the decision and order in Cases 92-ERA-19 and 92-ERA-34, and has concluded that the decision does not preclude the staff from proceeding with its licensing decision.

The matter of enforcement actions for the apparent instances of discrimination will be addressed separately in accordance with the normal enforcement practice in discrimination cases.
