Gentlemen:

This will confirm discussions with your staff concerning the upcoming preliminary site visit of the Watts Bar Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2.

The NRC environmental review team assigned to the review of your application for an Operating License will visit the Watts Bar site on August 25, 1976. We have made arrangements through Mr. M. Williford, of your staff, to meet at the site at 9:30 a.m. Mr. Oliver D. T. Lynch, Jr., the Environmental Project Manager, will be accompanied by 8 other members of the team with various technical interests and disciplines. The team will provide its own ground transportation. However, it is requested that a boat be available for a brief inspection of the reach of the river adjacent to the plants.

As the purpose of this initial site visit is strictly preliminary reconnaissance, to gain some familiarity with the site for the team, no formal question and answer meeting is scheduled for this visit. A more formal and thorough site visit will be scheduled for a later date, probably early in 1977, at which time we would expect to have detailed discussions with your staff.
