WATTS BAR NUCLEAR PLANT (WBN) UNIT 1 - 10 CFR 55.25 (INCAPACITATION BECAUSE OF DISABILITY OR ILLNESS) AND 10 CFR 50.74 (NOTIFICATION OF CHANGE IN OPERATOR OR SENIOR OPERATOR STATUS)

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Supplement 1 to Information Notice (IN) 94-14, "Failure to Implement Requirements for Biennial Medical Examinations and Notification to the NRC of Changes in Licensed Operator Medical Conditions," was released on April 14, 1997. This notice clarifies NRC's position regarding the reporting requirements of 10 CFR 55.25. In particular, this IN focuses on the need to define as part of the documentation certifying the medical condition of an operator, any condition for which medication must be taken on a continual basis. This submittal provides information of the type discussed in Supplement 1 of IN 94-14 for a group of licensed operators.

Listed in the Enclosure are the individuals for which updated medical information is being provided. Also included in the Enclosure is an updated NRC Form 396 for each of these operators.
