We should consistently use EIP. EPIP is not routinely used at SNC. The procedures fall into two groups: Implementing procedures and Administrative procedures. Implementing procedures are those that are used in response to the event, typically by the ERO. These are the procedures that are required to be submitted to the NRC under our current commitments.
