**Subject:** RE: Request for threatened and endangered species information

Brian,

I'm working on an environmental assessment for a Nuclear Regulatory Commission licensing action concerning an In Situ Leach (ISL) uranium recovery facility expansion in Converse County, Wyoming. Last June, I sent you a request (attached) for information concerning threatened and endangered species in Converse County, Wyoming, but I have not as yet received a response. The request letter is in our docket, but since I didn't actually lick the stamp, I can't be sure it was ever mailed. Anyway, I've attached the letter. Please note that I inadvertently omitted T35N, R74W Sections 8 and 16 from the area in which ISL activities could occur.

I have also been on the Mountain-Prairie Region website and found a Wyoming by county list of Federally listed threatened and endangered species, updated December 2006. I have used this as the basis for part of the ecological portion of the assessment. Is this list the most current?
