Gentlemen:

This is in response to your letter dated September 22, 1970, which enclosed a report of the final survey of your Middle River, Maryland facilities, and requested termination of Special Nuclear Material License No. SNM-1192.

Based on the data in your report and an inspection of these facilities by our Division of Compliance, we have determined that due to the insignificance of the contamination which may be present no hazard to health and safety is involved as a result of AEC licensed activities, and therefore an AEC special nuclear material license would not be required of any person receiving or possessing the subject facility. Accordingly, as requested in your letter dated September 22, 1970, AEC Special Nuclear Material License No. SNM-1192 is hereby terminated.
