Dear Mr. Matthews:

On August 28, 2007, MidAmerican Nuclear Energy Company, LLC (MNEC) submitted a new nuclear power plant letter of intent titled, "MidAmerican Nuclear Energy Company Combined License Application" and requested the information be withheld from public disclosure. MNEC believes the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has not completed its review of MNEC's request for withholding the information. The purpose of this letter is to request that the NRC withdraw from consideration and return the letter.

The letter should be returned in accordance with 10 C.F.R. 2.390(c)(3) because the letter:

- 1. Does not form part of the basis of an official agency decision, including but not limited to, a rulemaking proceeding or licensing activity;
- 2. Is not contained in a document that was made available to or prepared for an NRC advisory committee;
- 3. Was not revealed, or relied upon, in an open Commission meeting held in accordance with 10 C.F.R. part 9, subpart C;
- 4. Has not been requested in a Freedom of Information Act request; and
- 5. Has not been obtained during the course of an investigation conducted by the NRC Office of Investigations.
