Threat-Based Drill Workshop Security Involvement

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- Security involvement is critical to the success of the drill.
 - Relationships with Local Law Enforcement Agencies (LLEA)
 - Logistics Command Center / Staging /
 Communications
 - Interaction between Operations, Security, ERO and LLEA
 - Knowledge of procedures, indications and timelines



Relationships with Local Law Enforcement Agencies (LLEA)

- Primary agency for LLEA
- Routine meetings with LLEA
- Familiarization training for LLEA
- Enhanced Tactical Operations Training
- Security relationships with Intelligence networks



Logistics Incident Command Post (ICP) / Staging / Communications

- ICP primary location and alternative locations.
- ICP staffing and equipment.
- Unified Command Representation from Fire,
 EMS, Operations, JTTF and Emergency
 Management.
- Tactical Operations Center (TOC)
- Staging primary location and alternative locations.
- Communications capability and effectiveness.



Interaction Between Operations, Security, ERO and LLEA

- Joint Control Room Simulator scenario based training with Operations, Security, ERO and LLEA.
- LLEA involvement should include local agencies, SWAT and FBI.
- Realistic scenario based training between
 Operations and Security CAS/SAS.
- Open discussions between Operations, Security,
 ERO and LLEA on security events should be a part of this process.



Knowledge of Procedures, Indications and Timelines

- Security, Operations, ERO and LLEA should all be knowledgeable on procedures and policies and their potential impact on each other.
- Indications of evolving exercise events should be address and explained by the appropriate representative from the discipline affected.
- Timelines should be realistic and worked out in advance with "Trusted Agents" from all discipline involved in the exercise.
