SUBJECT: SOUTH TEXAS PROJECT COMBINED-LICENSE APPLICATION

Dear Mr. Puype:

On November 29, 2007, the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) accepted the South Texas COL application for Units 3 and 4 for docketing and began its review. Under the NRC-DHS Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), this begins the 10-day period for the NRC to provide the docketed application to the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) (a preliminary copy of the application was provided to your office on November 15, 2007).

The NRC-DHS MOU identified 90 days as the period for consultation. During our working level meetings, the staff clarified the consultation period to be 90 working days after the conclusion of a 10 working day period after the application is docketed. Therefore, we have scheduled April 23, 2008 as the date for the receipt of the Consultation Report. If there are problems in meeting this date, please contact me at your earliest convenience.
