It seems vital to me that the NRC hold a series of scoping hearings, which was discussed as a possibility at the meeting in Sweetwater. The public has no forum to express concern for the potential threat to species resulting from Watts Bar. TVA has no public utility commission. Citizens haven't been heard since the 1970's.

I was glad to see and hear you last night. I know it is silly but government officials or agents or commission members have seemed unaffable or impersonable to me in the past. Meetings like the one at Sweetwater can help bring people together, to give both sides faces and voices.
